Scholarship Application

To ensure that your application is reviewed and processed as quickly and accurately as possible, please read and follow these procedures and requirements as written.

REQUIREMENTS

All Applicants must:

1. Have been granted the Eagle Scout rank or have verified that their applications for Eagle Scout rank have been received at the national office by December 31, 2022. Have earned a Religious Emblem Award during their tenure as a Scout.
 2. Applicants must reside in or have received the Eagle Scout Award in a Troop/Crew within the Cape Fear Council territory.
 3. Submit applications that are postmarked no later than midnight June 7th and are received by the Cape Fear Council by the June 10th deadline. Use sufficient postage.
 4. Be a graduating high school senior entering college or higher educational institution within twelve months of graduating high school.
 5. Provide a transcript of high school grades completed. You may attach with the application.
 6. Be available to participate in a minimum of two seminars during the scholarship.
 7. Submit **one** essay giving your opinion of:
What does "Duty to God" and "Patriotism" mean to you? And what role will they play in your future as you work to become a role model as an American citizen?
- Please answer in the form of an essay, not each question followed by its own answer. Limit your essay to 1000 words.
8. Have demonstrated leadership ability in Scouting and a strong record of participation in activities outside of Scouting.
 9. Provide two signed recommendation letters from individuals who can speak to the integrity and motivation of the applicant and know the applicant. These are the only endorsements required.

PROCEEDURES

- Complete the application personally.
- Only attach requested items in the requirements (no biographies, resumes, or supplementary lists of activities). Items should not be stapled to the application.
- Answer all questions on the application. ("See attached" is not an acceptable answer).
- Attach no more than eight pages to the application (i.e., recommendations, high school transcript).
- Submit all attachments with the application form to ensure that all items are available for review at the same time. (The Cape Fear Council cannot assume responsibility for matching items that come in separately).
