FEATURING KEYNOTE SPEAKER RON YOUNG



Chief Warrant Officer Ron Young is a decorated U.S. Army combat veteran, former Apache Longbow helicopter pilot, and Eagle Scout. During the opening days of Operation Iraqi Freedom, his helicopter was shot down over Iraq, and he endured 23 days as a prisoner of war before being rescued by U.S. forces.

Following his military service, Ron served as a CNN military contributor, a White House political appointee, and a search-and-rescue and emergency medical helicopter pilot. He is the recipient of the Bronze Star, Purple Heart, Air Medal with Valor, and Prisoner of War Medal. Today, Ron is completing a Master of Divinity in Chaplaincy at Liberty University and is dedicated to helping veterans and civilians overcome adversity, trauma, and life's greatest challenges through faith, resilience, and service.
